LOCALISATION OF A NEW GLOBAL NETWORK: THE CASE OF STREAM NETWORK CAMEROON

In December 2023, the HEDECS led the launch of the STREAM NETWORK in Cameroon a meeting to discuss and validate the strategic plan for 2024-2028, setting the stage for its effective localisation.

The STREAM (Cameroon) is a new network, borne out of the STREAM Network created out of a 4-day meeting held in Nairobi, Kenya, from 30 September to 3 October 2022, hosted by Positive Young Women Voices of Kenya. STREAM stands for Stepping Stones Trainers Engaging with Activist Movements. The Nairobi meeting brought together feminist women rights activists living with HIV from Argentina, Cameroon, India, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda and Zimbabwe. They came together with the aim of seeking to uphold and maintain the SRHR of women and girls in all our communities in the context of HIV, irrespective of our HIV status.

STREAM NETWORK Cameroon is a feminist activist's movement women-led, apolitical, non-profit, non-sectarian, non-governmental organization headquartered in Bamenda in the North West Region of Cameroon since 2023. It is borne from the Nairobi Kenya Meeting of 2022. The STREAM Network is a new network created out of a 4-day meeting held in Nairobi, Kenya, from 30 September to 3 October 2022, hosted by Positive Young Women Voices. STREAM stands for Stepping Stones Trainers Engaging with Activist Movements.

Mbzigha-a Beltivate, STREAM Focal Person for Cameroon was HEDECS representative in the Kenya meeting and a key driver of the technical review and high-level meeting. Localisation of the STREAM network has been an exciting and daunting task. Exciting as there is increasing interest to know more, to be part of the network, the Country Focal Person has been able to have 14 strategic members in the network and 12 are representing 7 Regions of the 10 Regions of Cameroon.

However, the localization schedule came at the time when national stakeholders including UNAIDS, UNICEF, CARE where busy with end of year programs/activities such that having meeting(s) suffered postponements. STREAM Global and Stepping Stones accompanied us in this process bringing their expertise to guide and coach.

Moving forward, HEDECS will continue with the STREAM Network localization and engage with community mobilisation, stakeholders buy in, resource mobilisations at national and international levels

Through the STREAM NETWORK, HEDECS is strengthening its commitment to improving health and empowering communities with strong community and partner engagements
